

It is by looking at his cross that we begin to understand. This world that God loved so much, we should love it too. If we love God, we must love all our brothers and sisters, all the people of this world too.

It's an everyday fight against the forces of evil. But the Lord does not abandon us. Saint Paul tells us that nothing can separate us from his love. With the Gospel, we are more than ever in the mercy of Jesus. On this first day of the week, he re-joins his disciples. He finds them living in fear, distress, and in locked rooms. However, they cannot count on him anymore. They now expect to suffer the same fate as their Master.

This danger is always present: how to face the mockeries of a world that thinks itself intelligent, of a world that attacks the Church teaching, and Christian values? We can see that it is not easy to live one's faith in today's world.

The temptation is great to fall back into small ghettos and stay in our comfort zone. On this Sunday, we pray to the Lord to be with us so that we are more courageous in the testimony, and also keep us more generous in the practice of fraternal charity. Amen


