From the Pastor's desk

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

In today's Gospel Jesus invites his disciples to "love one another as I have loved you." This New Commandment is based on "agape" love - that is, unconditional love that seeks the good of the other; a love that is NEVER self-serving. It is this love which underpinned everything that Jesus said and did throughout his life. And it is this love which must be at the basis of our living out of the Gospel of Jesus in our lives.

Each one of us know the ways that we are called by God to be loving people who care for others, even those who persecute us. However, we need to ask ourselves how we can improve our interaction with those with whom we come into contact.

Are there areas in our lives in which hate or envy or jealousy or any form of negative emotion must be destroyed, so the "agape" love can replace them? Are we willing to let the Spirit of our loving God help us to walk in the footsteps of the Lord more closely?

Let's reflect on the Lord's New Commandment for us in the week ahead: "love one another as I have loved you."
