# **Fourteenth Sunday Ordinary Time** 5 July 2020

#### Reflection

Sunday's Gospel begins with Jesus's saying a prayer of praise and thanksgiving. Jesus addresses God as Father, showing his special intimacy with God. In his reference to the wise, from whom God has hidden the significance of Jesus's ministry, Jesus is clearly speaking of the scribes and Pharisees. But Jesus is also referring to the unrepentant cities that he cursed in 11:20-24. God chooses to reveal his message of the Kingdom to the "infants," Jesus's followers. Even though Jesus's disciples lack social status or formal education in religious matters, they are able to comprehend what Jesus came to reveal about God the Father. In human relationships, the bond between a father and a son is unique. They often have a mutual understanding of each other that is not shared with anyone else. Through Jesus, the Son of the Father, believers can now come to know God fully. In the past, no human being really knew God. Now the way to come to know the Father completely is through Jesus.

Matthew often speaks of the heavy load the scribes and Pharisees laid on their people—the many rules and regulations that directed the daily lives of Jews. Jesus promises that those who follow him and take up his way of discipline will find rest and renewal. Jesus invites his disciples into a relationship with him—a relationship of gentleness and humility. Jesus cannot be accused of being lax, because he is inviting his disciples into a very disciplined way of life; but Jesus says this way of life will be easier because it is built on a relationship with a loving and caring God.

# ARRIVING AT CHURCH

If you are not feeling well, DO NOT come into church.

Entry is via the side door next to the kitchen. Exit is via the front door.

- Wash your hands with soap and water before leaving home.
- Provide social space in entering the building, at least 1.5m apart.
- Use the hand sanitiser provided after signing in.
- Sit at pews that are not taped off (every other one will be closed). There is a limit of one individual or family unit at each end of the pew.

#### **COMMUNION PROCEDURES**

- Communion, only under the form of the host, will only be offered in the hand.
- Remember to keep your distance, watching the markings on the floor.
- Follow the signs on the floor.

# MASS DEPARTURE PROCEDURES Exit is via the front door.

- Priests and staff will not be able to talk with you as you leave, but please know we truly care about you and offer you our greeting.
- There will be no hospitality after any Mass. Please do not stop and visit others. Once in the parking lot and, maintaining distance of a car width between you, you may visit with friends and others. Just because we are being cautious does not mean people cannot be friendly.
