



## Second Sunday of Lent 13 March 2022



Welcome to the community of the Catholic Parish of St John 23rd Glenwood-Stanhope Gardens where the love of Christ is shining in so many ways.

Just as each year the first Sunday of Lent recalls the temptations of Christ, so do we contemplate the transfiguration on the second Sunday every year. Its subject of light is present today from the opening of the first reading (Genesis 5:5-12,17-18) in the command that warms the hearts of astronomers “Look up [Abram] to heaven and count the stars if you can”. This image is employed three times in Genesis, and is referred to several other times. It may be a reminder to those in cities that in former, pre-industrial times that lacked the modern pollutions of mechanical exhaust and light (yes, to astronomers the lights of modern life are pollutants) that the stars of night are truly a spectacle to behold. Those blest to live with clear skies find themselves awe-struck by the beauty of the stars, if they but occasionally venture out to look up; adolescents and young adults often delight to do so, but a world weariness too often takes over and, sadly, too many cease to see.

In the accounts of the transfiguration the three chosen disciples (Peter, James and John) do see Christ’s glory in the scene that in iconography is depicted as heaven breaking forth into the world. The synoptic accounts signify this by the cloud (a bright one according to Matthew) that overshadows them; it is the same as the cloud that accompanies and hides the Israelites during their flight from Egypt, at Sinai, and in the Tabernacle and the Temple. From the cloud, be it described as darkness that hides or as blinding brightness, the voice speaks. The scene is reminiscent of the baptism in the Synoptic gospels, each agreeing that the voice from heaven refers to Jesus as “my beloved Son”, with whom the voice is “well pleased”. Here at the transfiguration Luke has this element as “my Son, the chosen one”, but all three add the command “Listen to him!”.

The Homiletic Directory lays particular emphasis on the three synoptic gospels attaching this scene to Jesus first predicting his death. The connection to his death is highlighted in the interpretation found in today’s Preface, and in the reports that put the same three disciples with Jesus in Gethsemane on the eve of his execution. But perhaps more note should be taken of the specific detail that immediately precedes in his statement to the disciples “...there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see – the Son of Man coming in his kingdom (Matthew 16:28); – that the kingdom of God has come with power (Mark 9:1); – the kingdom of God (Luke 9:27)”. Then we are told how three of them did soon see this manifestation of the kingdom. Matthew’s version may suggest to some an indication of the end of time, but that would be an inordinate length of time for any of the disciples to have to live out. Mark and Luke give no such sense. The disciples witnessing of the transfiguration is a privileged foresight of the glory that is more fully revealed in the resurrection – which no one witnesses; no one sees him rise, and in each encounter with the risen Christ there is some level of obscurity and they cannot see him fully as he is. The three disciples enjoy a privileged foresight of his glory, and thereafter none see it until they have tasted death and enter the homeland of heaven, when the creative power of God will transfigure these wretched bodies into copies of his glorious body. But that statement of Paul’s should not be read as an anti-material rejection of the body, nor as a denigration of earthiness; his rejection is to the weakness of earthly life that make people subject to the Law and to being enslaved by earthly concerns. After all, in the transfiguration Christ reveals in his very flesh the presence of the kingdom of heaven; the body set free from slavery to sin is free to be as the child of God it was intended to be.





We would like to extend our gratitude to those who have already made contributions. It can be in memory of a deceased love one or your family or personal gift to the parish community.





**What we are doing at Vinnies**

The impact of the flooding in northern NSW has been devastating and is a further blow to a community that was adversely impacted by floods in 2021, bushfires in 2020 and the COVID pandemic.

NSW SES teams have received over 8800 calls for assistance, so far, with 300 flood rescues overnight alone. Further evacuations are in place today and you can check the affected areas [here](#) and access a list of current evacuation centres [here](#).

A Flood Response group at Vinnies has been formed and will meet regularly over the coming days to coordinate our response – to both support our people in affected areas and provide the most appropriate care and assistance to communities impacted by the floods.

The Society has launched a [Vinnies NSW Flood Appeal](#) / (St Vincent de Paul Society NSW - Flood Appeal ([vinnies.org.au](http://vinnies.org.au))) and is getting ready to support the community with financial payments as part of the recovery efforts. Members will lead this response on the ground, offering support at recovery centres and Society locations that are accessible. More information on this work will be shared as we establish our supports in key centres and as the floodwaters recede.





