Welcome to the community of the Catholic Parish of St John 23rd Glenwood-Stanhope Gardens where the love of Christ is shining in so many ways.

The Lectionary gives a certain pride of place to John's gospel in Eastertide; every Sunday gospel is taken form it, except the Seventh to which Ascension has been relocated in Australia. Only the first three Sundays' pericopes are post-resurrection. Today's (John 20:19-31), like that on Easter Sunday morning (John 20:1-9), is read each year, and the two form a natural fit with these two Sundays since they encompass the eight days and together form one story. The first part of today's with the bestowing of the Spirit and the commission to forgive or remit sins or debts (v.19-23), repeats on Pentecost Sunday, thus encompassing and identifying the Eastertide as one unit: the whole of the mystery of the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ and the inbreathing of the Holy Spirit into the community of disciples to commission the Church.

The missing episode between the frames of the two Sundays' readings is that of Mary of Magdala. She encountered Christ risen and he told her not to cling to him yet today he invites Thomas to probe his wounds. As a child this story captivated and revolted my imagination since it was not possible to hear it without imagining myself in Thomas' position, performing the invited actions; there is a distinct recollection of wanting to wipe or wash my hands. Less captivating to the child's mind, yet enshrined especially in liturgical practice, is the Lord's greeting of "Peace (be) with you." This ancient greeting, witnessed several times in the Hebrew Scriptures, is employed by both Luke and John as the Lord's greeting in the post-resurrection appearances. Here in John it is the immediate precursor to the Church's being commissioned in her reception of the Spirit, the divine breath that brings the newformed or newborn Church to life, just as God's breath animated Adam when first formed from earth. This new-begotten creature is authorised to forgive sins, to remit debt—the same mission of proclaiming forgiveness mentioned in Peter's speech in last Sunday's second reading.

The element of believing is reiterated in a nuanced manner in today's second reading (1 John 5:1-6), which we also read earlier this year on feast of the Baptism of the Lord: whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, is a begotten child of God. This belief is not merely an assent of the mind or heart but is manifested in love for the Son, and indeed therefore for all God's children, as John had explained earlier in this letter (and will unfold over the next four Sundays). To believe in the Son requires forsaking the wrongful ways of the world, and living his ways. This shines through the somewhat idealistic description of the common life of the new Church in the first reading (Acts 4:32-35). Each year we read one of the passages from Acts of the Apostles that describes this common life. This year's puts the apostles' testifying to the Lord's resurrection at the heart of this common life. But the gospel reminds us that to forgive sin, or remit debt, is to believe in him and is to testify to his Resurrection.

When the disciples said, 'We have seen the Lord,' he answered, 'Unless I see the holes they made, and unless I can put my hand into his side, I refuse to believe.' Eight days later the disciples were in the house again and Thomas was with them. The doors were closed, but Jesus came in and stood among them. 'Peace be with you,' he said. Then he spoke to Thomas, 'Put your finger here; look, here are my hands. Give me your hand; put it into my side. Doubt no longer but believe.' Thomas replied, 'My Lord and my God!' Jesus said to him:

'You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe.'

There were many other signs that Jesus worked and the disciples saw, but they are not recorded in this book. These are recorded so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing this you may have life through his name.
